

S.T.O.P. Training Course

Course Aims

To provide participants with the knowledge, skills and understanding to manage situations where domestic abuse has taken place and confidence to deal constructively with perpetrators.

- Understanding emotions
- Understanding domestic abuse
- Understanding the process of change and resistance to change
- Developing empathy
- Impartiality and safety
- Strategies for support
- Warning signs of abuse
- Internal organisational support and supervision
